COMMITTEE MEETING 24/5/2010

MINUTES

Present: Carol, Jon, Tony, Peter, Diane, Trystan, Hugh.

Apologies: Jackie, Keith, Nigel, Sarah, Adrian.

Minutes: The minutes were read and signed by the Chairman as a true record.

Matters Arising: Trystan was welcomed to the Committee.

Jon asked if there had been any feedback from GWAS after their AGM. Diane replied that nothing had been heard.

Open Tournament: Carol has received 16 entries so far. 20 entries are needed to make the tournament viable. Some Club members have not put their names down yet, and the cut-off date is 30th May. It was agreed that a decision would be deferred until then.

Carol has received a request from a disabled archer, asking if it would be possible for someone to score for him and retrieve his arrows. This was agreed.

Peter kindly agreed to run the barbecue, as Trystan will be unavailable.

Forecast Rounds: Carol proposed, and it was agreed, that archers should stick to the forecast rounds as posted by Jackie. It is good practice to shoot different rounds. Diane will put up a notice. It was also agreed that the Lizards round should be dropped, as this no longer has relevance.

Hall or Field Shooting Locations: Carol pointed out that the beginning of the Outdoor Season is always very confusing, especially for the beginners, with archers not knowing whether they were shooting outdoors or indoors. She felt, and it was agreed, that there must be a deadline and it must be adhered to. It was suggested that as early May nearly always brings bad weather, we move the cut-off date back two weeks, and compensate by shooting outdoors for the first two weeks of October, when the autumn weather is usually fine. Tony suggested that this should be put to the Club at the AGM, and this was agreed.

Treasurer's Report: This was brief, as the Treasurer was on holiday.

Balance in Current Account after paying rent of Hall: £ 814.31

Balance in Deposit Account: £3158.92

Records Officer's Report: There was no report, as the Records Officer was on holiday.

Equipment Officer's Report: There is a shortage of stands for bows to be put away, both here and in the Hall. All the bosses are in good order. Bob had mentioned that the wooden frames of the foam bosses are gradually being chipped away. He suggested that pieces of rubber could be tacked over them to prevent this, and this was agreed.

One of the 18lb training bows has a broken limb, and there is also a broken limb on a 68" 18lb bow. Tony will order new ones.

Amenities: Everything is under control.

Any Other Business: Trystan asked when the Have A Gos were being held. Carol confirmed that they would be on the last Saturdays of June, July and August, 10 am to 4 pm. Tony, Trystan, Diane, Adrian, Jon and Sarah are available to help on 26th June, and will be at the field at 9.30 to set up.

On Sunday 27th June we have been asked to run a Have A Go at Mullion School. Trystan and Diane agreed to do this, and Trystan will ask Alison if she will come as well.

Mrs Brincat's Taster is going ahead on the 25th May.

Carol said she had been contacted by an archer who had shot with us and wanted to join the club, but was not sure when he would be able to raise the entry fee. It was agreed that for insurance purposes he could not shoot with us until he had paid his fee.
